

09 NIGHTS/10 DAY





#### **ARRIVAL AT GUWAHATI**

- > Upon arrival, meet our representative and drive to Guwahati city. Check into the Hotel.
- Later visit Maa Kamakhya which is an ancient seat of tantric and shakti cults of Hinduism and considered the most important shrine of Assam, Nabagraha Temple a place considered for a great centre for the study of Astrology and Astronomy in the past. Also visit Guwahati Zoo, State museum & Emporium which is well laid out complex displaying various aspects of Assam's culture, history and crafts.
- Optional: River Cruise at Brahmaputra river on extra costing.
- > Overnight stay at Guwahati.



## **GUWAHATI-JORHAT**

- After early breakfast, check out and drive to Jorhat (310 kms/6 hrs) Jorhat was the first town of the Upper and central Assam installing electricity supply in 1923. The first aeroplane on north-eastern soil was landed in Jorhat in 1928. Jorhat Gymkhana Club is the oldest golf course in Asia and third oldest in the world. The world's oldest and largest Tea Experimental Station is located in Jorhat. It was the last capital of the Ahom Kingdom and home to many historical monuments of Assamese culture.
- Overnight stay at Jorhat.









## **JORHAT TO MAJULI ISLAND**

- A very early check out from the hotel and drive about 40 minutes to JETTY(Harbor)to catch a ferry to go to Majuli Island. In the Brahmaputra River forms the second largest riverine island of the world, Majuli, which spreads over 924.6 square kilometres with a population of about 150,000. The island, threatened with constant erosion by the mighty and unstable Brahmaputra River, had been the principal place of pilgrimage of Vaishnavites since the age of the Ahom rulers. Several Sattras(monasteries) resembling those of medieval times are headed by Satradhikars teaching Vaishnavism, which was introduced by Srimanta Sankardeva (1449–1568).
- \*The timing( to & fro) Majuli Island is scheduled only twice a day (Early morning at 07:00 a.m & Afternoon)
- > Overnight stay M.I.



#### **ISLAND EXCURSION & TO KAZIRANGA N.PARK**

The morning session is scheduled to go for excursion and explore the island which is considered to be very rich with species of floras and faunas harbouring many rare and endangered avifauna species including migratory birds that arrive in the winter season. Among the birds seen here are: the greater adjutant stork, pelican, Siberian crane and the whistling teal.









# **EXCURSION & TO KAZIRANGA N.P.**

- In the afternoon, leave for JETTY (harbor) to ferry again back to Jorhat and then drive to Kaziranga National Park which is about 115 kms/3 ½ hrs drive. Kaziranga National Park is spread on an area of 858.98 sq.kms and is a home of about 70% of one horned rhinoceros of the world.
- Overnight stay at Kaziranga.



#### **KAZIRANGA SAFARI & EXCURSION**

- Early morning explore any one zone of Kaziranga National Park on back of Elephant. Apart from the Rhino, other species found are Hog Deer, Swamp Deer, Wild Buffalo, Elephants and if you are lucky then tiger also. It is also home to pelicans, storks and darters as there are a number of water bodies inside the Park. Return to the resort for breakfast. In the afternoon enjoy jeep safari through the National Park. Return to the hotel
- > Overnight stay at Kaziranga.









## **KAZIRANGA-SHILLONG**

- After breakfast, drive to Shillong (245 Kms/6 hrs.) Enroute visit Umium Lake, a majestic placid lake with its surrounding sylvan hills. Arrive Shillong. Check into the hotel. Evening free.
- At an altitude of 1496 mtrs above sea level, Shillong is a lush fold of the eastern Himalayas with a restful environment.
- Over Night stay at Shillong.



#### SHILLONG-CHERRAPUNJEE

- After Breakfast start for a 2 hours drive to Cherrapunjee which is a myriad land of mystic, a dreamland of clouds and fogs earns the distinction of being the wettest place on earth. Nohkalikai is a hauntingly beautiful waterfall, cascading down from the top of the gorge to the mystic deep green pool below. Other places worth seeing are Mawsmai Cave, Seven Sister Falls (Noh Sngithiang), Thangkharang Park (This is also a view Point of the Kynrem Falls) and the Giant Conical Rock/Mot Trop.
- > Overnight stay at Shillong.









#### SHILLONG SIGHTSEEING

- Start a day tour visiting some of the beautiful tourist attractions of Shillong covering Elephanta falls which is situated at the outskirts of the main city of and is 12 kms away from the city. The unique part of Elephant Falls is that it is a two-tier waterfall Wir Phang Falls and the Wei Iaplam Falls set in the dingles of the rocks. The other attractions are, Shillong Peak, Lady Hydari Park, Laitumkhrah Cathedral, Wards Lake, Golf Course, State Museum.
- > Overnight stay at Shillong.



## **SHILLONG-GUWAHATI**

- After the breakfast at the hotel in Shillong, it is a 03 hours/100 kms drive to Guwahati and check into the Hotel, Lunch at Hotel.
- After lunch, visit Maa Kamakhya which is an ancient seat of tantric and shakti cults of Hinduism and considered the most important shrine of Assam, Nabagraha Temple a place considered for a great centre for the study of Astrology and Astronomy in the past. Also visit Guwahati Zoo, State museum & Emporium which is well laid out complex displaying various aspects of Assam's culture, history and crafts.
- > Overnight stay at Guwahati.
